Every six months, District 4 Toastmasters presents the Communication & Leadership Award to an individual or organization who demonstrates excellence in both areas. This year the award goes to Bob Rybicki from the Youth and Family Enrichment Services (YFES) - a private non-profit agency that provides free and low-cost services to San Mateo County residents who are struggling with substance abuse, domestic violence, mental health, communication and relationship issues.

YFES believes that everyone deserves the chance to be healthy and strong, no matter what challenges life has handed to them. The youth who serve on YFES's San Mateo County Youth Commission recently conducted a community needs assessment that indicated that teenage sexuality, drug use, and violence were serious and worsening public health concerns. They developed a series of recommendations to address these issues, and are presenting their ideas to top county officials to incorporate into the County's strategic plan.
